1. The graduation rate is the number of graduated students divided by the number of students available for graduation.

2. The Number of Graduates Available for employment are those that do not fall into one of the following categories: death, incarceration, active military service, the onset of a medical condition that prevents employment, or those who are international students who are enrolled on the bases of a student or work visa and rare ineligible for employment in the US post-graduation. However, if international students represent the majority of the total starts for the program, then the school may not use the "international student" exclusion.

3. Percentage of graduates employed in the field is calculated by dividing Graduates Employed in the Field by the Number of Graduates Available for Employment. Graduates employed in the field are those who obtained jobs in the field for which the training provided.

4. The Graduate Jeweler Program did not have start dates during this reporting period.
